Enjoy apple picking at Melick's Town Farm Cider Mill & Orchard in Oldwick, followed by a mid-day Box Lunch at Natirar County Park in Peapack – Gladstone and a hard cider tasting session in the afternoon at Burnt Mills Cider Farm in Bedminster. The Farm is owned and operated by the Melick Family. It's been in the same family for ten generations and is one of the largest commercial orchards & cider production centers in New Jersey.

The Park was once the home of Kate Macy Ladd, heiress to a whaling, shipping and oil fortune, who built the beautiful brick Tudor mansion on top of the hill (formerly known as Maple Cottage) overlooking the North Branch of the Raritan River.

The Cidery is one of only four cideries in New Jersey. The name Burnt Mills was taken from an unincorporated area in Branchburg Township at the confluence of the Lamington River and North Branch of the Raritan River.

Enjoy a morning hike at Hacklebarney State Park in Long Valley, followed by a mid-day box lunch at Morristown National Historical Park – Jockey Hollow in Bernardsville and a beer tasting session in the afternoon at Oakflower Brewing Company in Millington. The Park was created in 1924 with a single land gift of 34 acres from two of its local residents - Adolphe & Sarah Borie. Today, this 1,000-acre park is said to be the most beautiful park in all of New Jersey.

The Hollow was created in 1933 and was the site of George Washington's encampment of 2,000 Pennsylvania soldiers during the hard winter of 1779-1780.

The Brewery just opened for business Thanksgiving Weekend in 2022. Situated on Main Street in quiet downtown Millington, it is the closest brewery to Bernardsville and has received a lot of good reviews on Yelp.

Tour the Jacobus Vanderveer (Knox) House & Museum in Bedminster, followed by a mid-day box lunch at Willowwood Arboretum in Bedminster and a wine tasting session in the afternoon at Tomasello Winery at Alstede Farm in Chester.

The House was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1995. It was the home of Jacobus Vanderveer and served as General Henry Knox Headquarters during the American Revolution the winter of 1778-79.

The Arboretum, originally named Paradise Farm, was founded as a private arboretum by Henry & Robert Tubbs in 1908. Today, The Arboretum features some of the largest trees and rarest plants in New Jersey.

The Winery evolved from what was once a fruit farm in Hammonton, NJ founded by Frank Tomasello in the early 1930s. Today, The Winery is the only third generation family-owned winery in New Jersey. They grow over 30 different varieties of grapes and produce nearly 50 different types of wine.

Tour the class rooms and walk the halls of our alma mater, followed by a mid-day box lunch in the BHS Cafeteria and a private showing of *American Graffiti* in the afternoon at the Bernardsville Cinema.

The School was originally located on Olcott Avenue. In 1927, the town built the school we remember. In the mid '60's, just before we attended this school, a junior high school and cafeteria were added. After we graduated in '73, the junior high school was moved to Seney Drive.

The Cinema was built in 1910 by Frank Allen (a developer

of other important buildings in downtown Bernardsville). In 1913, it opened as a 500-seat vaudeville theater – 100 in the balcony, 400 on the main floor. Over the past 113 years, many companies have owned and operated the theater business inside this building. Bernardsville Cinema took over in 2019.

American Graffiti, directed by George Lucas and produced by Francis Ford Coppola, is a coming-of-age comedy drama about a group of high school friends on their last night of summer vacation in 1962. In 1995, the US Library of Congress deemed the film "culturally, historically, or aesthetically significant" and selected it for preservation in the National Film Registry.
